Dear Exhibitor,

We have done our best to put together another exciting day for exhibitors and spectators alike. There will be many vendors showing their wares, a coloring contest and stick horse building for the kids, and several equitation/showmanship classes.

The Main Ring will start at 9:00 am. We have continued this year with several classes for the National Show Horses. The kids will be strutting their stuff with their outfits and stick horses at about 4:00 pm. The Hunter Ring will start at 8:00 am with a warm up, schooling class and then the Children's Division, Low Working Hunter Division, and Walk-Trot Division. In the evening we will have the Saddlebred, Miniatures, and the Easy Gaited Classes winding up with the Indian Performance Class.

Special entertainment will be presented at about 5:00 pm by the Northern Ohio Mounted Shooters. They will ride with two 45 caliber pistols loaded with special blanks for hitting targets at close range. They ride at a full gallop while doing this. It should be very exciting.

For the eighth year we will offer a Hunter Pace through the Metroparks on Saturday, starting at 10:00 am (\$20.00 fee per rider). Ribbons will be awarded at the completion of the Pace and a picnic will be held in the Main Tent.

For the second year we will have Saturday, August 1, afternoon activities with 10 Welsh Driving Classes and carriage classes.
