All paybacks will be mailed to exhibitors after the show.

Showmanship, Equitation, & Horsemanship Classes—Pre-Entry \$5.00; Post Entry \$8.00; Awards & Ribbons.

Halter & Performance Classes—Pre-Entry \$10.00; Post Entry \$15.00; Ribbons, & \$20, \$12, \$10, \$5, \$5

The Show Committee has the right to pay back only ½ the pre-entry fees for the first five places in all classes with seven or less exhibitors.

Jackpot Classes—Pre-Entry \$20.00; Post Entry \$25.00; with 80% of Pre-Entry Fee (40%,20%,10%,5%,5%)

Liberty Class - Entry \$25.00; with 80% of entry fee payback (40%,20%,10%,5%,5%)

Grounds Fee: \$10.00 per horse if showing out of trailer.

Office Fee: \$5.00 Per horse

STALLS:

Box stalls available at **\$50.00** each (no bedding furnished) on a "RESERVED BASIS" FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED, WITH ADVANCED PAYMENT ONLY. Tack stalls--**\$50.00** each, limited availability. State time of arrival and departure when ordering stalls (Mail in reservations only. No phone calls, please!). Stalls will be available after 6:00 PM on Thursday. Stall Manager will be on grounds and available until 10:00 PM on Thursday, Friday, & Saturday. If arriving after 10:00PM it will be necessary to bring your own bedding. Baled pine shavings will be allowed at the exhibitor's expense. Shavings will be available for purchase on grounds. Fees for travel trailers and campers or any other type of electric hookup-- \$30.00 per day; \$50.00 for weekend. Campers are not permitted on grounds until after 12:00 NOON on Thursday. NO EXCEPTIONS. A surcharge of \$100.00 may be assessed to those vehicles that arrive prior to the designated schedule as set forth above. No entries will be accepted and no exhibitor will be permitted to show until payment is made. Anyone bringing golf carts or other motorized vehicles onto the grounds must register them with the show office. The registration fee is \$10.00. Operators must have a valid drivers license.

IMPORTANT –READ CAREFULLY

All entries shall be made by the exhibitor or owner, and no animal admitted for exhibition unless the entry blank is duly signed by the exhibitor or owner (trainer signature not required). In amateur classes and novice classes, the appropriate cards must be shown at the time of entry. All out-of-state horses will be required to have a Veterinarian's Negative Coggins Certificate.

A RECOGNIZED COMPETITION MAY REFUSE ANY ENTRY OF AN EXHIBITOR OR THE PARTICIPATION OF ANY AGENT, TRAINER, RIDER, DRIVER, OR HANDLER WHO HAS SHOW AN OBJECTIONABLE ATTITUDE OR BEHAVIOR AT A RECOGNIZED COMPETITION OR TOWARDS ITS MANAGEMENT, WHICH MANAGEMENT IS ABLE TO SUBSTANTIATE, OR FOR PREVIOUS UNSPORTSMAN LIKE BEHAVIOR AT A RECOGNIZED COMPETITION WHICH MANAGEMENT IS ABLE TO SUBSTANTIATE.

No refunds on entries except by Veterinarian Certificate.

The show committee will enforce "ZERO TOLERANCE" to inappropriate behavior, unsportsmanlike conduct, and violence, as so deemed by said show committee. Engaging in any violence, or threatening any violence on this show grounds, will result in immediate expulsion from the premises. The Ashland County Sheriff will escort violators from the premises, with no refunds given. "Violence" includes, but will not be limited to, physically harming another, shoving, pushing, harassing, intimidating, coercing, and threatening or talking of engaging in those activities. It is the intent of this show committee to ensure that everyone associated with this organization never feels threatened by anyone's actions or conduct while participating in this event.

IN REGISTERED BREED CLASSES: EXHIBITORS MUST HAVE COPIES OF REGISTRATION PAPERS ON HORSE BEING EXHIBITED.

The basic rules of all COSCA classes conform to the basic official breed rules. In some cases where breed rules are not available for us to pattern after, the COSCA Rules Committee has created its own rules. Should any question or dispute arise, not provided for in the rules, the decision of the Show Committee shall be final. The Committee reserves the right to add or adjust the list of judges as they deem necessary. The Show Committee assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to persons, horses, or personal property, from any cause and upon this condition only are entries accepted. No persons will be allowed in the show ring at the time of judging, except those having duties to perform. The Show Committee reserves the right to prohibit any person from showing or attending any horse in the ring, and to remove any person from the show grounds without being liable for compensation. Any exhibitor making protests shall lodge his protest in writing with the Steward immediately after the award is given, with a deposit of \$50.00 cash, which sum shall be forfeited to the Horse Show if the objection is not sustained.

Absolutely no bikes, skateboards, roller skating, roller blades, or hand scooters in barns, buildings, or beyond barricades. If found to be in violation, any of the above listed will be confiscated. They will be returned to the parent. All dogs must be kept on a leash and under full control at all times.

All Walk-Trot entries must not have cantered at any COSCA approved Shows with the exception of the novice class entries and Open Walk-Trot Pleasure class entries.

ALL—BREED MUSICAL LIBERTY CLASS RULES (limited to 15 entries): Liberty is demonstrating the natural beauty of the horse. Horses are to be judged on style, grace, animation, gaits, and presence. Open to any breed of stallions, mares, or geldings. Horses must be two years of age and over. Horses are to be shown without tack or equipment, exceptions being protective leg wraps and bell boots. Horses may be decorated according to their respective breed or musical theme. A maximum of two (2) minutes time limit will be allowed per horse. The official time begins when the halter is removed from the horse. The horse must perform at its natural gaits, both clockwise and counterclockwise. Horse may

receive cues from a whip only but it cannot touch the horse. Two handlers per horse are allowed in the ring with the horse. Handlers must be twelve (12) years of age or older. Handlers may not touch, ride, or handle the horse at any time after their music starts (CDs only, please. NO CASSETTES). Horses must be caught and haltered within two (2) minutes or be penalized. Entry free for the Liberty Class is \$20.00 and must be made on the Championship Show Entry Form. Entries must be made prior to the mandatory Liberty Class meeting. A mandatory Liberty Class meeting will be held in front of the Entry Booth, Saturday afternoon at 4:30 p.m. All eligible participants must be in attendance with your music.

Year End Trophies and/or Ribbons: Will be awarded to the 5 High Point places for horses, ponies, or riders in various classes listed as approved COSCA point classes. Horses eligible to receive such awards must be present. Owner or authorized agents or representatives previously designated to the Point Secretary must be present to receive such awards. Riders eligible to receive trophy or ribbon under the point system must be present to receive award. If a class receiving year-end awards is not offered, the winners will be notified as to when they can pick up their awards.

Adult Amateur, Youth Activity, and Divisional High Point Awards: All awards displayed in the Merchants Building will be available for pick-up after 2:00pm on Sunday. No Exceptions. If a recipient is unable to pick up their award(s) at that time, please make alternate arrangements with the appropriate chairperson for pick up at a later date. If a recipient would like to include their awards in a photo, they may do so as long as the awards are returned to the booth after completion of the photo shoot. Again, make arrangements with the specific chairperson. Awards may not be removed from a booth except by the appropriate chairperson.
